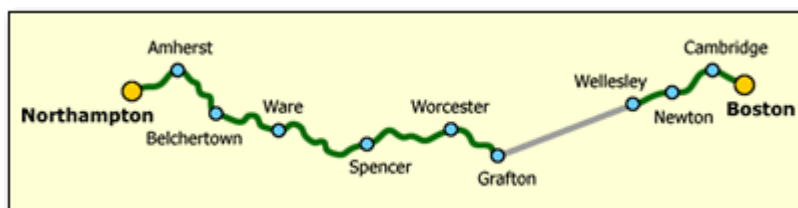
Detailed Daily Schedule
